

Support Batwa Education through the Kellermann Foundation

In Uganda, parents must pay school fees for their children to receive an education. The Batwa are among the poorest of the poor, sometimes existing on less than \$25 a year. For most of them even local school fees are impossible, and fees for the better schools are beyond imagining. Many generous donors have helped sponsor children's education over the last 15 years, and the education program is now one of the most important elements of the Batwa Development Program. Currently over 80 Batwa children are receiving an education at the Bishop's Primary School, a boarding school that is considered the best school in the region. Several hundred other Batwa children attend various local schools.

The Batwa elders and parents are making sure the tribe's children are educated in the ways of the forest and their heritage. Yet they also understand the importance of raising the first generation of children who can eventually become pastors, teachers, accountants, nurses, and other professionals, helping their tribe to become self-sufficient. The challenge is great, and the need is growing. Please consider a gift to support a Batwa student:

- \$1,400/year for a secondary school student
